

The below instructions provide some guidance, but you can also get creative and really make the wreath your own. You will need pruning shears/sharp scissors and may want to wear gloves to protect sensitive hands.



1. Gather your materials. Your kit comes with a wreath base, twine, bunches of greenery, and accent pieces. Remove any rubber bands and fluff your greenery. Eco tip: Save your rubber bands for another use!



2. Make a bundle of mixed greenery, using 3-4 stems per bundle. Trim greens as needed to 6-7". Strip any needles from the bottom inch or so. Cut 2.5' feet of twine and use it to tie your bundle tightly, leaving two 8-10" tails.



3. Repeat step 2, making 8-10 bundles total. Place more unique greens at the front and mix up varieties to add interest to your wreath.



4. Tie one bundle of greens to the base of your wreath, wrapping the twine tightly. Double knot the wreath at the front of your wreath base to keep the back tidy.



5. Place the next bundle a few inches down the wreath base, keeping the greenery facing the same direction as the first. Tie it to your base tightly, with the knot on the front.



6. Continue adding bunches until one quarter of your base is full. This will take 3-5 bundles, depending on how bushy you want your wreath.





7. Now begin filling the other quarter. Place a bundle opposite your first bundle and going in the opposite direction.



8. Continue tying bundles onto your base until both sides meet.



9. Add accent pieces (magnolia, winterberry, pinecones) to cover the twine. You can also mix accent pieces in throughout your greenery. Tip: If some twine is still peeking out, tuck extra greenery directly into the grapevine to hide it. Don't worry about making it perfect – part of the charm is this wreath's rustic look!



Tips for Freshness

Your greenery was cut fresh from our farm, and with a little care should last for many weeks. Store outside in the cold, out of direct sunlight. You can spray your wreath lightly with water every few days to help it stay fresh. Birds may snack on the winterberry – we have not used any preservatives for this reason. Share your wreath on social media and be sure to tag us!

P.S. This wreath and all packaging is **100% compostable!** Please compost it or let it biodegrade in your garden. Feel free to return it to the farm for us to compost! Thanks for helping us stay environmentally friendly.
